Seminars Background

The first session will provide information on how to properly identify security threats to intranets, Internet and extract connections within the corporate enterprise network environment

The second session will be based on simple statistics; any site connected to an untrusted network (such as Internet) will be attacked in some manor at some time. Some attacks will be simple “knob twisting” attacks, designed to probe defense: Others will be carefully planned and extremely dangerous to corporate health.
